Dear Shul Members and Guests,

Having experienced a remarkable first few weeks at Ohel Moshe, it is with great anticipation and excitement that we have begun to formally plan for the Yomim Noraim.

Intuitively, and driven by the yearning for a comfortable, welcoming and energetic environment, our new Shul has hit the ground running with beautiful Tefilos, inspiring and insightful learning opportunities, and a strong sense of Achdus, and this is only the beginning! Undoubtedly, you can expect this trend to continue to enhance with what is sure to be a moving and meaningful Yomim Noraim.

While it is our hope to be able to expand the Shul in the near future, it's unlikely that a new space will be ready for use in time for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. In order to produce the appropriate atmosphere for the Yomim Noraim, please take note of the following items:

**Seating:** Seating will be limited to reserved seats only and the number of seats will be limited to provide ample space for a comfortable Tefilah. Each seat will be either at a table or with a Shtender. Seating is on a first come first serve basis, and members have priority over non members. In order to accommodate family groupings please reserve seats as soon as possible. The cost per seat is \$100 for members and \$175 for non members.

**Ladies Section:** We have already completed the downsizing of the men's restroom to create a wider opening between the Men's section and the Ladies section. With this wider opening, there should be a significant increase in the ability for sound to carry from the men's section in to the women's section and this will as well provide a view of the Bimah from parts of the ladies section. If needed, we are also looking in to the installation of a Plexiglas shield in front of the Amud which would reflect the sound of the chazzan more directly in to the Ladies section.

**Playroom/DayCare:** Significant improvements have been made to the playroom as well, including new furniture, carpeting, and more toys. A babysitter(s) will be hired to supervise the children in the play room during Davening on the Yomim Noraim. In order to limit any potential interruption from the playroom, a layer of sound proofing will be put on the wall that separates the playroom and Shul. Also, the exterior basement door will be available as an alternative for entering and exiting the playroom or to reach the ladies rest room.

Please, return your seating requests to the Shul ASAP to allow for proper planning. We are looking forward to sharing a very meaningful Yomim Noraim with you and your family. Feel free to contact us with any questions, suggestion, or concerns.
